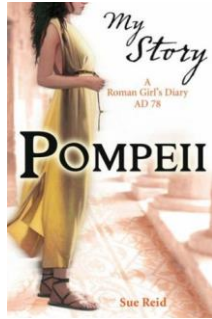


## English

This term will be:

- Exploring 'Pompeii' by Sue Reid, which is a series of diary entries written from the perspective of a Roman girl.
- Looking at newspaper reports and writing our own reports about the Roman invasion of Britain!
- Writing a persuasive advert to recruit Roman soldiers and creating leaflets about the Roman way of life.
- Studying and writing explanation texts focussing on how different rock types are formed.



## Science

This term will be:

- Exploring rocks and soils and identifying how materials that come from rocks are used in and around school.
- Learning about different types of rocks and how they are formed on Earth.
- Taking part in practical activities, including researching rocks, separating and sieving materials and conducting an investigation into the permeability of different soils!

## Computing

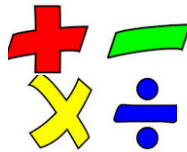
We are going to make a simple animation in Computing using 'Scratch' software.



## Mathematics

This term will be:

- Working with numbers up to 1000 and 10,000.
- Partitioning 3 and 4 digit numbers.
- Use calculations and written methods to add and subtract 2 and 3 digit numbers.
- Double and halve 2 digit numbers and recognise odd and even numbers.
- Rehearsing and learning our times tables and learning division facts for 3, 4, 5, 6, and 8 times tables.
- Finding quantities of numbers using fractions.



## Geography

We will be exploring volcanoes and earthquakes.

This will link with our History topic of the 'Romans'. We will look at Italy and the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in A.D. 79, which destroyed the city of Pompeii.

## Languages

Learning about greetings and numbers using the story L'ecole des signes.

## Art and Design

Roman mosaics and creating clay sculptures.
