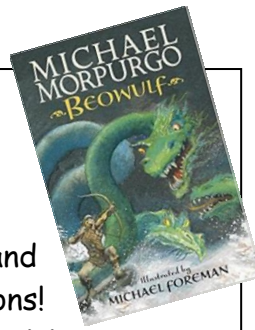


## English



This term will be:

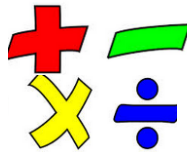
- Exploring 'Beowulf' by Michael Morpurgo and using this as inspiration for our own versions!
- Looking at non-chronological reports and writing our own explanation on why the Anglo Saxons invaded and settled in Britain!
- Writing a descriptive poem on our local and surrounding area.
- Creating a fabulous set of instructions on how to make our very own magnet!

## Science

This term will be:

- Exploring forces and magnets, including magnetic materials and their properties.
- Learning about different materials and sorting them according to their characteristics.
- Taking part in practical activities, including researching magnetic and non-magnetic materials!

## Mathematics



This term will be:

- Working with numbers up to 1000 and 10,000.
- Partitioning 3 and 4 digit numbers.
- Using calculations and written methods to add and subtract 2 and 3 digit numbers.
- Using calculations and written methods to multiply and divide numbers.
- Rehearsing and learning our times tables and learning division facts for 3, 4, 5, 6, and 8 times tables.
- Finding quantities of numbers using fractions and exploring equivalent fractions and decimals.

## Computing



We are going to make a simple animation in Computing using 'Scratch' software. Class 3 will become software designers!

## Geography

We will be exploring our local area. Class 3 will investigate the landscape and unique geography of our local area, our local town, city and amenities and using maps to deepen our understanding.



## Languages

Learning about birthdays through the story 'L'anniversaire d'Aurélié' and learning about numbers and animals through the story 'L'école magique'.

## Art and Design

We will be looking at the work of J.R.R. Tolkien, the author of The Hobbit and The Lord of the Rings. He also created many pieces of art for his written creations. We will focus on sketching and watercolours as the media for our own pieces.
