English

Class 1 will be reading:

- traditional tales and stories in familiar settings.
- nursery rhymes and poems
- simple non fiction texts

Foundation will:

- begin to sound and recognise letters of the alphabet.
- recognise and begin to write their own name and simple words
- begin to recognise some of the high frequency words.



Maths

Foundation children will:

- Recognise numerals — 0 to 20
- Count sets of objects up to 5, 10, add to 20.
- Say and use number names in familiar contexts.
- Begin to find 1 more
- Recognise and describe some 2D shapes.
- Compare the length and weight of objects
