English

Class 2

Class 2 will be reading traditional tales and stories in familiar settings, poems, non fiction texts and recounts.

Y1 pupils will:

- identify and write questions.
- write simple stories, poems and recounts.
- be re-telling known stories.
- read a variety of poems on similar themes.

Y2 pupils will:

- be working with non fiction texts to make simple notes and to write non-chronological reports.
- be re-telling known stories.
- start to compare books written by the same author.
- compare and contrast preferences and common themes in stories and poems.
- read a variety of poems on similar themes.
- be learning about nouns, verbs, adjectives, similes and how to use inverted commas to punctuate speech.



Maths

Class 2 pupils will:

- recognise odd and even numbers.
- count in 2s, 10s, 5s and 3s.
- identify the number that is 1 and 10 more or less.
- use addition and subtraction facts to 20.
- find totals using coins and give change from 20p and to a £1.
- measure capacity, introducing unit of a litre.
- understand and identify examples of symmetry.
- looking at multiplication facts for 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10 times tables
- learning the doubles of all numbers to at least 20.
- understanding halves and quarters and how to write these as a fraction.
