Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) received

£3,960

Summary of PPG spending 2015/16

In our school we used this funding to:

- Provide additional hours for a teaching assistant to deliver FFT Wave 3 intervention programme and Dyslexia Outreach follow up work.
- provide TA hours to deliver ongoing Speech and Language support activities.
- provide additional hours for a teaching assistant to facilitate a small nurture group each afternoon.

Summary of spending:

- £80—Provision of tinted exercise books and turnabout dice for select pupils
- £20—Funded an after school club for a FSM pupil
- £3860—towards additional teaching assistant hours to deliver Dyslexia Outreach work, Turnabout Programme and FFT Wave 3 intervention programme.

Impact of spending:

- The pupil receiving the FFT Wave 3 intervention programme has made significant progress. She now has a reading age that is in line with age related expectations.
- Speech and language support is ongoing but progress is being made.
- For the pupil receiving Turnabout, there has been a significant increase in his attention and retention of information. His maths and reading ages are now in line with his chronological age.

Summary of PPG proposed spending 2016/17

- Provide TA hours to deliver a bespoke Speech and Language programme to one pupil and to carry out FFT and Turnabout interventions to a further four pupils.
- The impact of this additional 1:1 support will be measured by pupil reading age being increased to being in line or above chronological age.
