Class 3 World War II Experience

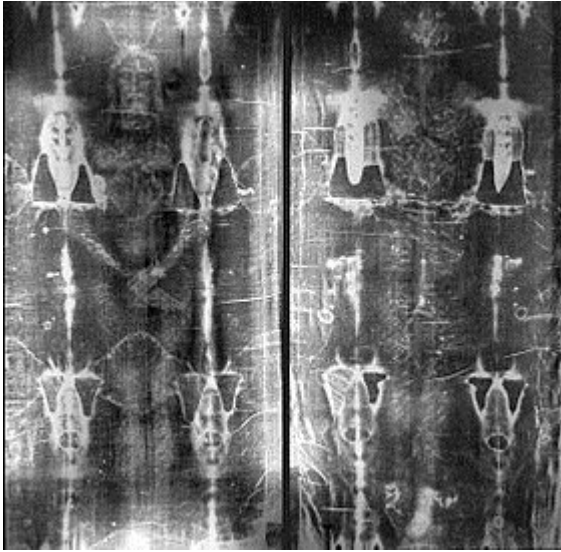
On Thursday 30th March, the children of Class 3 visited The Museum of Cannock Chase for a World War II experience.

A replica of the Turin Shroud will be on display from Friday 7th July until Tuesday 11th July at Rangemore Church.

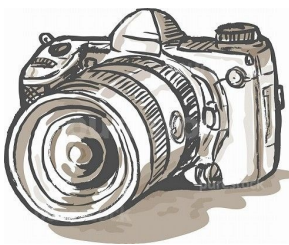
Celebrating the new bell tower at Draycott Church
